

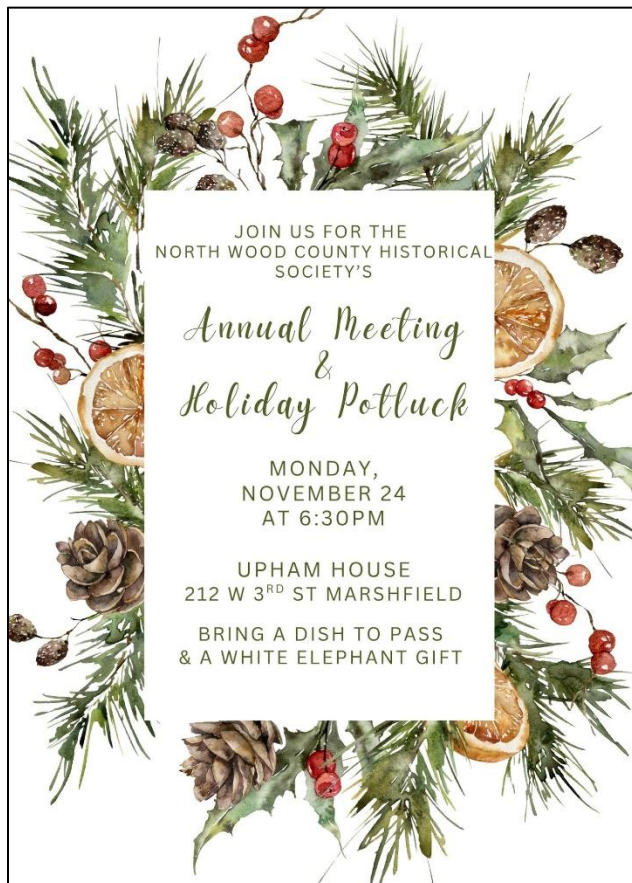

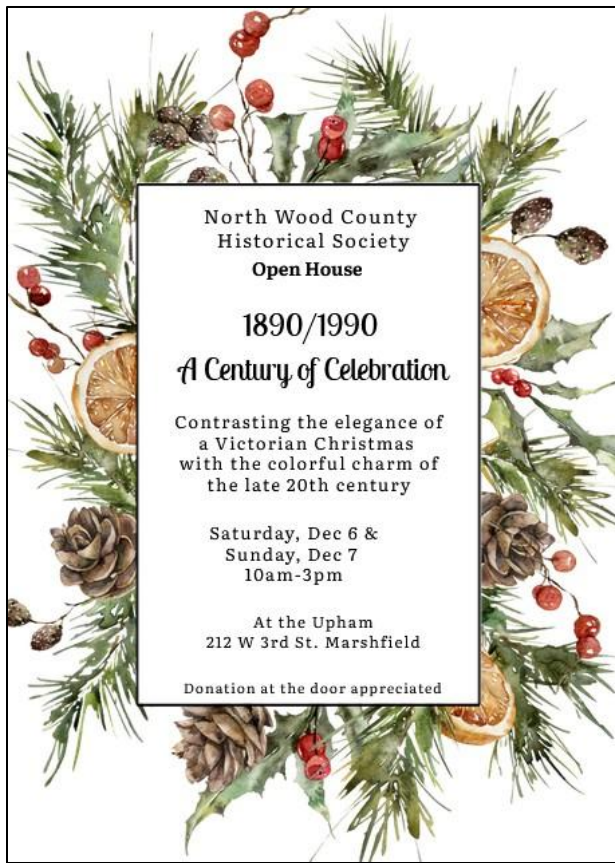
As the year draws to a close, we invite members, friends, and volunteers to gather for our Annual Meeting and Holiday Potluck.
